29. *International Symposium of Excavations, Surveys and Archaeometry* hålls i Kocaeli (Izmit) 28 maj-1 juni 2007. Det är min önskan att resa dit för att genomföra två uppgifter:

1) En uppdatering i de senaste forskningsresultaten som berör tidig bronsålder i Mindre Asien. Under arbetet med min avhandling om denna tid i det egeiska området stod det klart att starka influenser eller inflyttningar kom österifrån. Jag vill arbeta om avhandlingen till ett tryckfärdigt manus och letar efter fler bevis för de teorier jag framlade. Den stora konferensen i Kocaeli är det enda forum där de absolut senaste arkeologiska resultaten från hela Turkiet presenteras.

2) Intervjuer med arkeologer som arbetar i Turkiet. Sedan tidigare känner jag och har haft kontakt med både utländska och inhemska, män och kvinnor, äldre och yngre som har lång fälterfarenhet i landet. Tanken är att det antagligen finns vissa skillnader mellan hur dessa grupper uppfattar omgivningarna och arbetsförhållandena, men att dessa skillnader kanske är mindre än förväntat. Jag har tänkt sammanställa en blankett för att få ett statistiskt och anonymt resultat av dessa intervjuer, som jag hoppas ger ett relativt positivt intryck av arkeologens vardag i Turkiet. I dessa tider av västerländsk rädsla för muslimska länder hoppas jag att den här sortens undersökningar kan suddas ut en del fördomar och istället visa på de likheter som finns i motsvarande arbete i Europa. Kocaeli-konferensen är ett utmärkt tillfälle att få kontakt med många arkeologer för ett större underlag till undersökningen.
